

# U.S. Movies Win Prizes At Brussels

BRUSSELS, Belgium, April 28—(AP)—A New York art film director yesterday was awarded second prize in the international experimental film competition and four other Americans won lesser awards.

The \$5,000 prize went to Len Lye, New York, for his film "Free Radicals."

The \$10,000 first prize went to Walerian Borowczyk and Jan Lenica for their Polish film "Dom" (House).

Hilary Harris, New York; Francis Thompson, New York; Stan Brakhage, Denver, Colo., and Kenneth Anger, a San Franciscan who lives in Paris, won medals.

Nearly half of the 133 films entered were from the United States. There were some boos

in the World's Fair Auditorium when Belgian Interior Minister Pierre Vermeylen announced the results. An international jury studied the films for a week before deciding.
